EXECUTIVE CHAIRMAN'S STATEMENT

Three years ago, this administration came on board with a plan of action anchored on four distinct pillars of development and progress namely , Economic development, infrastructural development, Environmental sustainability, Government performance management, and social development Security, These strategic focus areas were carefully selected to align with Mr. Governor's THEMES agenda, ensuring that our local developmental efforts complement those of the state government for accelerated results and impacts on our people.

Under my leadership, Ibeju Lekki local government has tirelessly pursued the implementation of various projects and programs spanning these five domains. These efforts have garnered appreciation from residents, party members, and leaders.

During the unfortunate Endsars protest of the year 2020, the local government secretariat was set ablaze by unknown arsonists. In the aftermath of this tragedy, available office spaces have become insufficient for members of staff and management. Recognizing the considerable toll this has taken on productivity, our administration commenced the construction of a modern secretariat building to replace the one that was burnt.

This project is progressing at an impressive pace, and it is our expectation that the new complex will be completed on schedule to alleviate the current constraints on office space.

Having realized that the local government cannot rely entirely on the federal allocation to bridge the substantial gap in infrastructure and social services, our administration undertook a comprehensive overhaul of the local government's revenue collection and administration system. The introduced reforms have resulted in about 500% growth in our internally generated revenue over the past two years.

In our determination to bolster students' success in external examinations, Ibeju Lekki local government partnered with Pan Atlantic University to establish weekend coaching classes for final-year primary and secondary school students. These classes intensely prepare the students for common entrance exams, Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME), and WASSCE respectively. While Pan Atlantic University provides the faculty and venue of these classes, the local government takes care of all other logistics. This program has been running for 2 years with pleasant results as testaments to its beneficial impact.

The local government funds bursary awards for numerous undergraduate students of Ibeju-Lekki origin, supporting their aspirations for higher education. In the same vein, scholarships were awarded to primary school students who gained admission to federal government colleges to avert interruption of their educational pursuits on account of financial incapacity. Still, in the area of education, the local government



procures hundreds of JAMB and WASSCE forms annually, offering them to eligible students within the local government at no cost.

Concerned about the plight of Ibeju-Lekki residents who have had to endure long hours in traffic due to the ongoing construction of Lekki-Epe expressway, we established a local traffic management corp named Ibeju-Lekki traffic managers. This initiative was introduced to compliment the efforts of LASTMA and FRSC personnel, working collectively to alleviate congestion and facilitate free flow of traffic on the ever-busy Lekki-Epe expressway.

In line with our commitment to enhancing health care access and well-being, we undertook the comprehensive rehabilitation, renewal, and expansion of three primary health centers within the past three years. Our health work force was strengthened by the recruitment of doctors and additional health personnel, leading to improved health care delivery. Environmental sustainability has remained a top priority from the inception of our government. We recognized that a clean environment nurtures healthy and productive citizens. To underscore our dedication, we employed hundreds of street sweepers to sweep and keep our communities clean on a daily basis.

As a further demonstration of our commitment to clean environment, we launched the cleaner Ibeju-Lekki initiative program. This initiative involves the establishment of a dedicated team of young individuals who are equipped with the necessary tools. This team is consistently deployed to public spaces and government owned facilities such as schools and health centers throughout our local government area. Their mission is to eliminate over grown weeds and shrubs, ensuring the tidiness of these environments. Also, earlier this year, we

executed a large scale de-flooding exercise utilizing heavy equipment to clear blocked canals and water channels, opening up access roads to some of our communities in the process and preventing potential floods that could have overwhelmed several communities. The success of this intervention reversed the hitherto hopeless and helpless situation in the affected communities and residents were fully appreciative of the local government for coming to their aid during such a crucial time.

Over the last three years, our administration has diligently executed projects, implemented programs, and pursued policies within the limits of available resources. These efforts have generated substantial positive impacts for a wide range of citizens, earning us their trust, confidence, and accolade.

I extend my gratitude to the Lagos state government, our royal fathers, esteemed leaders and loyal members of our great party, the All Progressive Congress, Ibeju Lekki local government work force, community leaders, and the entire Ibeju-Lekki residents, without whose invaluable support and cooperation the modest strides and successes recorded in the last three years could not have been possible.

I reaffirm my unwavering commitment, along with that of my entire team, to continue serving the best interests of the majority of our people.

The Cleaner Ibeju-Lekki Initiative is a special local agency created by the Executive Chairman Engr. Hon .Abdulla Sesan Olowa from the inception of the administration with the sole aim of birthing a clean, safe, and environmentally friendly society. The agency is operated under the supervision of the Council Chairman, with a Technical Assistant in charge of its day-to-day operations.

STREET SWEEPERS

The Local Government has about 420 street sweepers whose job is to sweep our streets clean . This program was introduced in year 2021 and has been running sustainably without interruption



IBEJU LEKKI GARDENERS

The local government created the gardening unit and recruited about 30 young people , procured modern cutting machines which are used by the gardeners in thier daily operations . Their primary role is to ensure all public institutions are kept in an environmentally friendly condition . Institutions such as schools , health centers , libraries and palaces of traditional rulers .



WASTE POLICING

To ensure full compliance to our environmental laws , The Local Government created the waste police officers to arrest and prosecute offenders of indiscriminate disposal of waste on our roads and highways.



GARBAGE COLLECTION TRICYCLE

The Local Government in its effort to improve waste collection and transportation established the Garbage Collection Tricycle office and commissioned the project with 12 tricycles . This is to help residents collect thier waste and transport to designated dump site at very affordable rate on a pay as you go basis . This project is also a source of employment and revenue generation for the local government.

CLEARING AND RESTORATION OF PRIMARY CANALS- CHANNELIZATION

To mitigate this issue, the Local Government undertakes an annual massive clearing of all primary canals across the local government area. This channelization effort is crucial for preventing flooding and ensuring proper water flow. The key canals targeted in this initiative include:

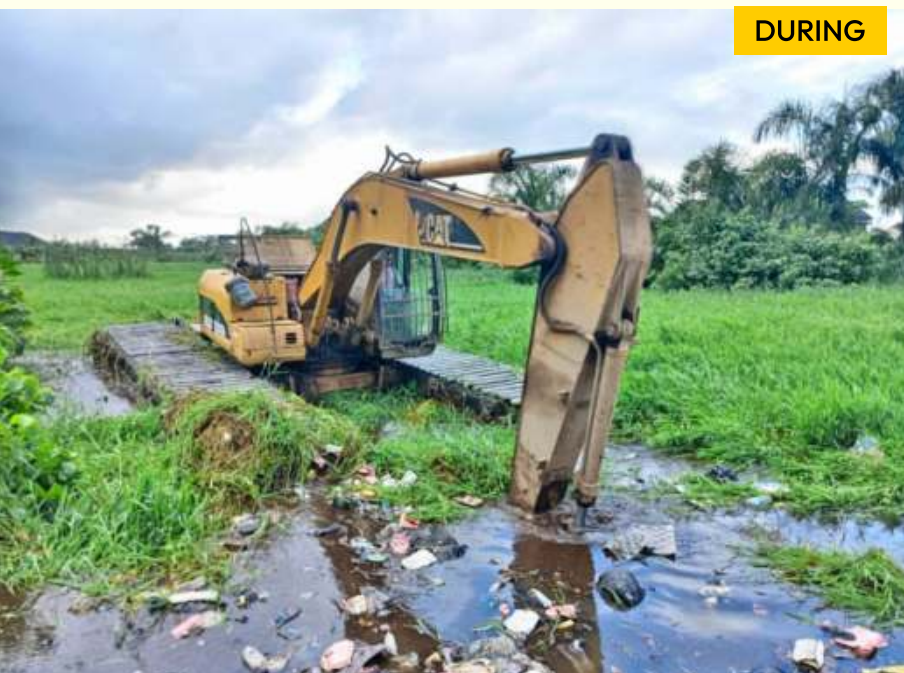

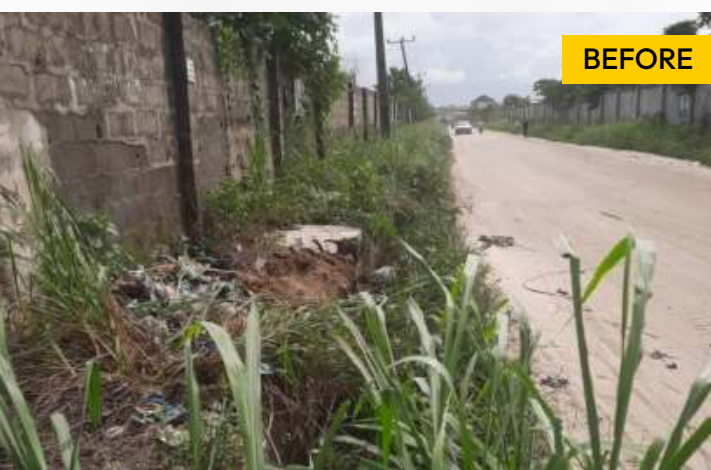

DRAINAGE DE SILTING

In addition to channelization, the Local Government also prioritizes the regular desilting of secondary and tertiary drainage systems. This process involves removing sediment and debris that can block water flow, reducing the risk of flooding. The key drains maintained under this initiative include:

- Bogije tertiary drain
- Lakowe phase 2 tertiary drain
- Awoyaya tertiary drain

FUMIGATION

Preventive and control measures against pests of public health importance in Ibeju-Lekki Local Government. To prevent infection, curb the spread of diseases, and comply with the public health laws of Lagos State (Cap III, Vol. VI), local government authorities conduct periodic disinfection, disinfestation, and deratization of various public facilities. This initiative covers schools, markets, primary health care centers, the local government secretariat, and Ibeju Lekki General Hospital on a quarterly basis. Here's an overview of these preventive measures:



Disinfection

Purpose: Eliminate pathogenic microorganisms (bacteria, viruses, fungi) on surfaces and in the environment to prevent infections.

Process:

Surface Cleaning: Clean all surfaces with appropriate detergents to remove dirt and organic matter.

Application of Disinfectants: Use hospital-grade disinfectants on surfaces like floors, walls, equipment, and furniture.

Fogging: Employ fogging machines to disperse disinfectants in the air, reaching inaccessible areas.

Disinfestation

Purpose: Control and eliminate insects (cockroaches, mosquitoes, flies, etc.) that can transmit diseases.

Process:

Inspection: Conduct thorough inspections to identify insect breeding sites. Insecticides: Apply insecticides in identified areas using sprays, gels, and baits

Traps: Set up traps for monitoring and reducing insect populations. Deratization Purpose: Control and eliminate rodent populations (rats, mice) to prevent the spread of rodent-borne diseases.



Process:

Inspection: Inspect facilities for signs of rodent activity, such as droppings, gnaw marks, and burrows.

Baiting: Use rodenticides in bait stations placed in strategic locations.

Traps: Employ mechanical traps to catch and remove rodents.

Exclusion: Seal entry points to prevent rodents from accessing buildings.

Facilities Covered

Schools: Ensuring a safe learning environment by controlling the spread of infectious diseases among students.

Markets: Reducing the risk of disease transmission in crowded public places where food and goods are sold.

Primary Health Care Centers: Protecting patients and healthcare workers from infections.

Local Government Secretariat: Maintaining a healthy workplace for government employees.

Ibeju Lekki General Hospital: Ensuring the hospital environment is free from harmful pathogens and pests.

Frequency and Compliance

Quarterly Basis: These preventive measures are carried out every three months to maintain consistent control over pathogens and pests. Adherence to the public health law of Lagos State, ensuring all facilities comply with health and safety standards.



Benefits
Public Health Protection: Reduces the risk of disease outbreaks in the community.
Compliance: Meets legal requirements and promotes good governance.
Environmental Safety: Creates safer environments for residents, workers, and visitors. By conducting these regular disinfection, disinfestation, and deratization activities, Ibeju-Lekki Local Government aims to protect public health and ensure the well-being of its residents and visitors.

TREE PLANTING EXERCISE

The environmental challenges like ocean surge, floods, irregular weather, and food scarcity are becoming more prevalent due to industrialization, which results in the emission of dangerous carbon and other greenhouse gases. To combat climate change, the Lagos State government, under the leadership of Babatunde Raji Fashola, initiated the Tree Planting Exercise in 2008. Ibeju Lekki Local Government has actively participated in this exercise as a continuous effort to mitigate these environmental issues.

Ibeju Lekki Local Government's Participation

Ibeju Lekki Local Government has been actively participating in the Tree Planting Exercise to continually support the state's efforts in mitigating climate change. The local government's involvement includes:

Community Engagement: Encouraging residents to participate in tree planting activities. **Public Awareness:** Educating the public on the benefits of tree planting and environmental conservation.

Sustainable Practices: Implementing sustainable land use practices to enhance environmental resilience.

Benefits of the Tree Planting Exercise

Environmental Protection: Enhances biodiversity and preserves natural habitats.

Climate Regulation: Helps in regulating temperature and improving air quality.

Economic Benefits: Promotes eco-tourism and provides raw materials for industries.

Social Impact: Improves the quality of life for residents by providing green spaces and recreational areas.

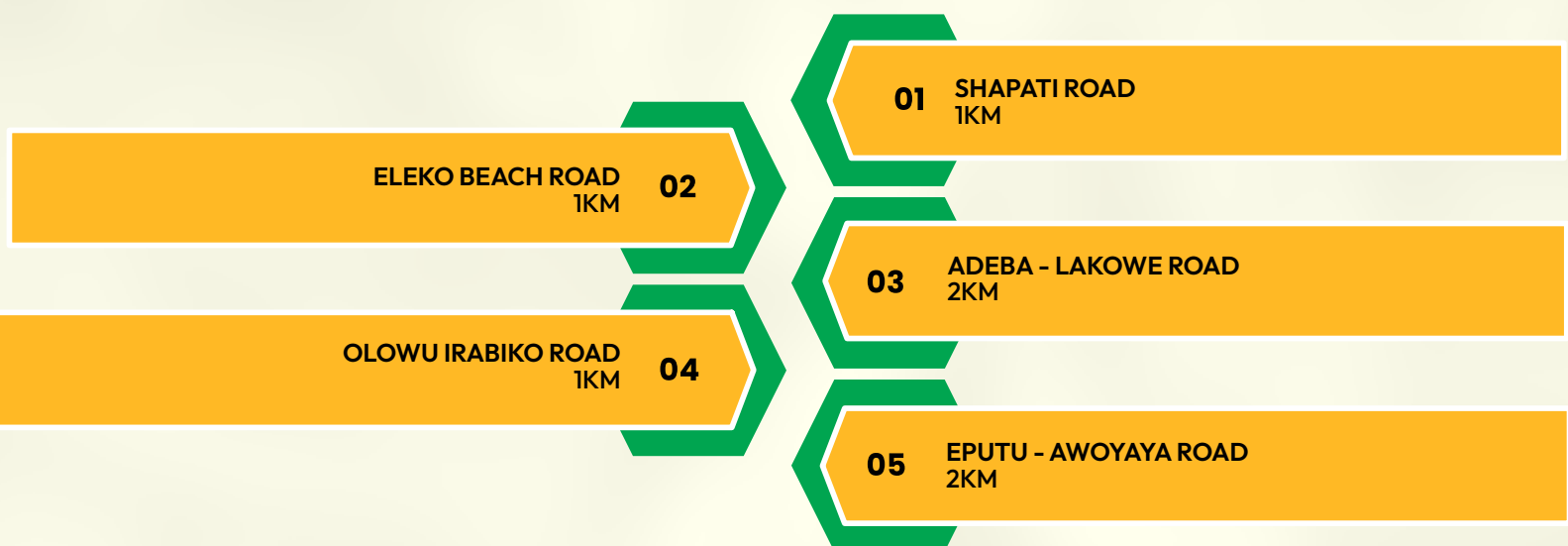

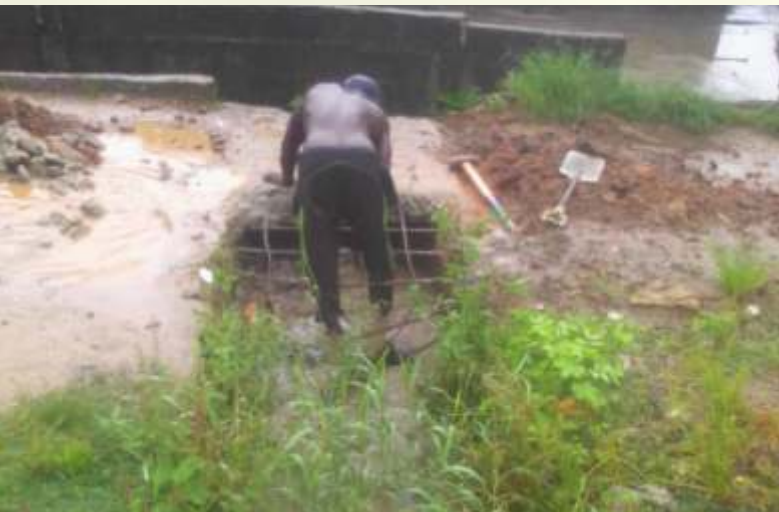

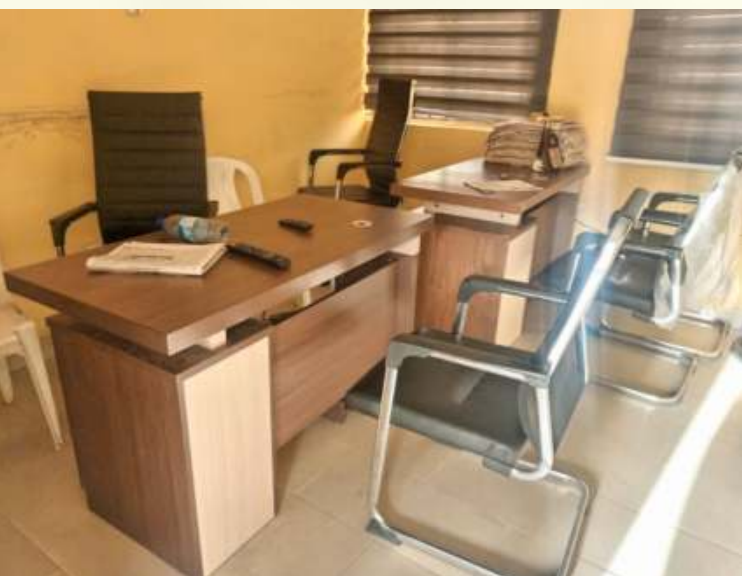

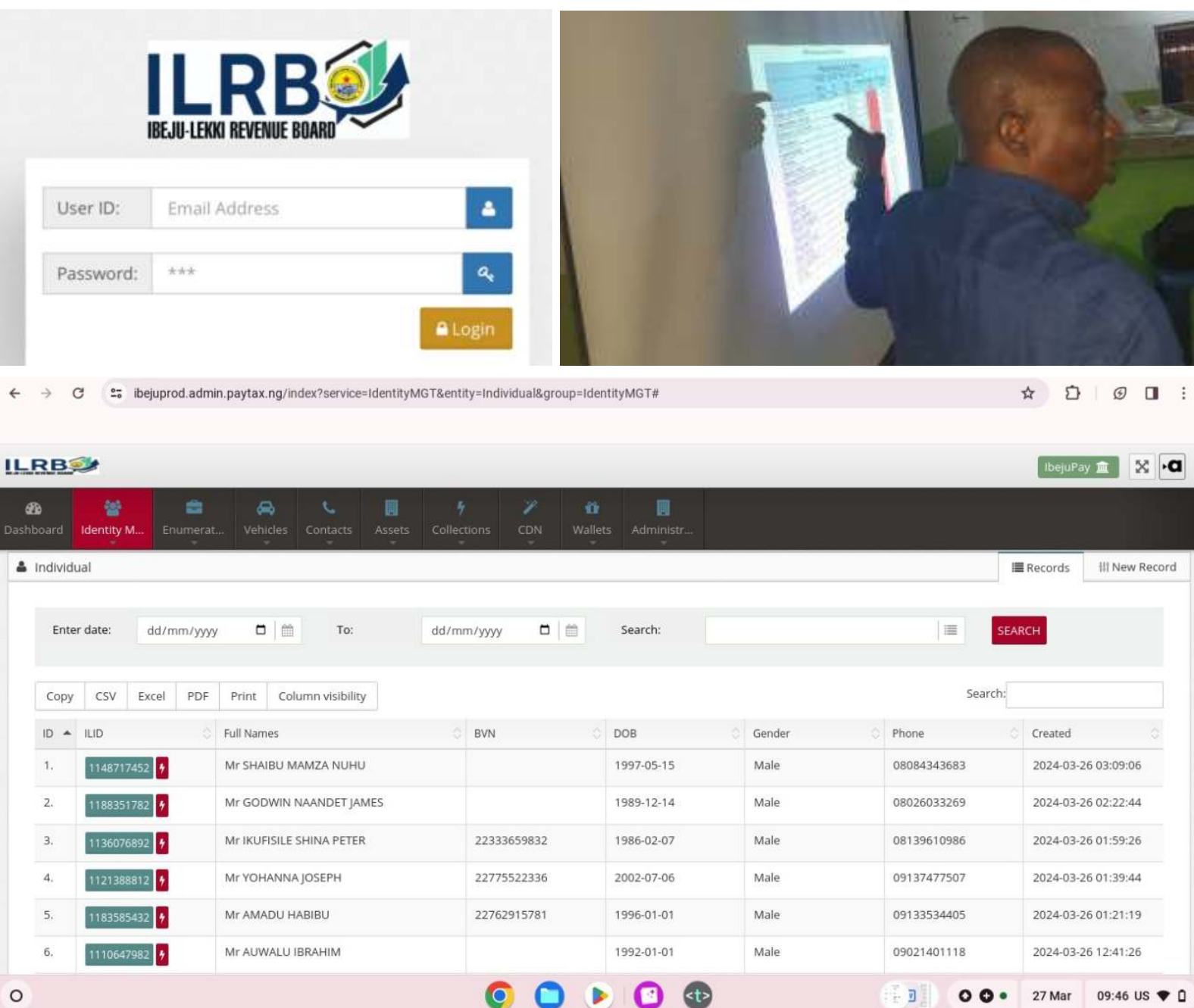

AUTOMATED INTERNALLY GENERATED REVENUE (IGR) COLLECTION ADMINISTRATION SYSTEM

This modern technological solution streamlines the entire revenue collection process, from assessment and invoicing to payment and record-keeping. By digitizing these operations, the local government optimizes efficiency, minimizes errors, and expedites the flow of revenue.

CREDIT FACILITIES TO TRADERS AND ARTISANS

Ibeju Lekki LGA has initiated a robust credit facility program to support traders and artisans. The first tranche of **N10,000,000** from a total of **N30 million** in **MSME** loans and grants has been disbursed. The grants are non-refundable and aimed at startups, while the loans are offered at zero interest for six months. This program is designed to empower small businesses and stimulate economic growth within the community.



MARKET DEVELOPMENTS

Ibeju Lekki LGA is currently spearheading the development of three key markets to provide modern shopping facilities for traders and consumers:



ABULE PARAPO MARKET

This market featured **80 lock-up shops**, offering secure and convenient spaces for local vendors.



**ELEKO MARKET**

With **250 lock-up shops**, this market catered for a larger number of traders, promoting commerce and business growth in the area.



TOURISM DEVELOPMENT DESK

The introduction of the Ibeju-Lekki Beach Carnival marks a significant milestone in the tourism sector. The inaugural beach carnival was the first of its kind in the history of the local government, aiming to boost tourism, attract visitors, and promote the cultural heritage of Ibeju Lekki. This event is expected to become a major attraction, contributing to the local economy and enhancing the area's appeal as a tourist destination.



AGRICULTURAL PIPELINE PROJECTS

In a bid to boost agricultural productivity, Ibeju Lekki LGA has secured approximately 10 hectares of land at Idi Ori under a long-term lease. This land will be utilized for cassava and plantain farming, with operations set to commence in the next farming season. This initiative aims to support local farmers, enhance food security, and contribute to the overall economic development of the area.



IBEJU-LEKKI OUT-GROWER SCHEME

In a bid to boost agricultural produce within the council area, we established the Ibeju-Lekki OutGrower Scheme, a cassava and plantain plantation at Idi-Ori. The initiative got the support of the Lagos State Ministry of Agriculture in providing tractors for massive land clearing. The out-grower scheme is designed to organise artisanal farmers into clusters for cassava and plantain cultivation.”





INAUGURATION OF OUT-GROWER SCHEME TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

To show our commitment in addressing food shortages and elevate agricultural production, we inaugurated a 9-member technical committee for the out-grower scheme. The terms of reference for the technical committee include government-sponsored land clearing, the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the local government and farmers, agronomy training for farmers, sourcing improved seedlings, and providing weeds and pest control for effective crop cultivation.





ECONOMIC RELIEF PROGRAMMES

As a Local Government, we have supported not just the economic engine but also the environmental, cultural, and social fabric of our community. Our Investment in Community markets has lead to sustained community growth, improved public well-being, and a resilient local economy which has in turn served over 9,000 residents as our price discount of over a hundred percent (100%) on food items met the consumption needs of the populace, On August 7, 2023, Ibeju Lekki Local Government held its first free food palliative programme at the Council Secretariat. Food items distributed includes, Garri, Rice of 5kg, Yams, Red Oil, eggs, Vegetables and Beans

These initiatives ensure that individuals and families have access to nutritious food options, reducing their vulnerability to malnutrition and related health problems.

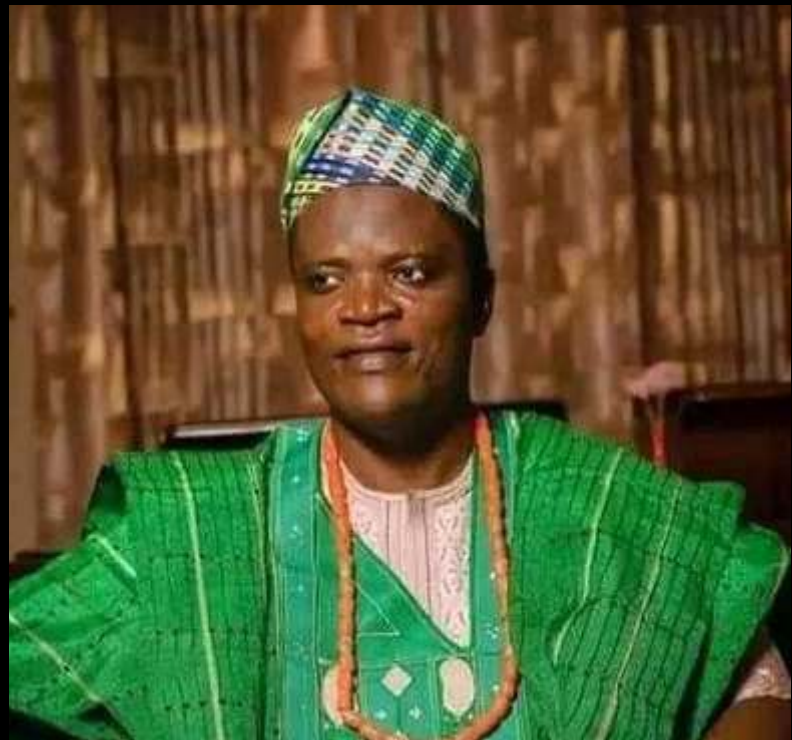
